To whom it may concern,

Continuing guaranty under the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act; the Poultry Products Inspection Act; and the Federal Meat Inspections Act, as amended by the Wholesome Meat Act.

The articles comprising each shipment of C50001 as material produced by Nexapack, LLC., 107 Laurel St., Summit Mississippi, are hereby guaranteed as of the date of shipment or delivery, not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act or any amendment there to; the Poultry Inspection Act, and the Federal Meat Inspection Act as amended by the Wholesome Meat Act: and furthermore, that they are not articles which may not, under the provisions of any sections of the afore cited acts, may be introduced into interstate commerce as long as the articles are used below 65c temperature.

Nexapack, LLC., further guarantees that C50001 as supplied may be lawfully used in food contact application under the FDA regulations 21CFR 177.1520. Users may make their own determination of safety, lawfulness, and technical suitability in their intended applications.

Nexapack, LLC., utilizes only virgin low density, and linear low density polyethylene resins in the manufacture of films and bags sold into the food and pharmaceutical applications.

This guaranty is continuing and shall be in full force and in effect until revoked in writing.
